As we strive to become more environmentally friendly and prepare our children in a rapidly moving technological world, we will be placing weekly homework tasks, notices, sharing learning and your child's achievements on Seesaw.

In the hope of making homework more manageable and effective, we will continue exploring this online tool, to share learning more efficiently between home and school. This should help to support children and parents at home through video tutorials and specific tasks.

Homework will be set every Friday and will be expected to be completed by the following Friday ready for marking. Please note in some instances some tasks may be marked as they are completed throughout the week.

We understand that this may take a few weeks to adjust to at home and school. Therefore, we will be modelling and explaining expectations to the children, whilst they are in school, in order to support the transition.

The log-in details to access your child's journal should not have changed however, an additional copy of their class code has been provided with this letter. Please keep this safe as this is their 'password' and will be the same code used in school.

If you encounter any issues, please speak to your child's class teacher. Seesaw can be accessed on computers (using the website web.seesaw.me), tablets and phones (using the Seesaw Family app).

Your child will only be identified by their initials. Seesaw only uses this information to provide the service and doesn't advertise in Seesaw, create profiles of students, or share or sell your child's personal information or journal content.
